GARBAGE CANS

Store all trash in cans that are:

- No larger than 32 gallons
 - Rodent- and insect-proof
 - Clearly labeled with the property owner's name and address in 3-inch letters
 - Secured by a lid and bungee cord; place cans in your garbage bin
- A first violation carries a penalty of up to \$500.

GARBAGE (landfill)

Each house is allowed up to 6 garbage cans per collection. Homeowners will be charged for cans in excess of the 6 permitted.

RECYCLING

Put glass, plastic, and metal in a can marked "Recycling." Do not bag. Flatten and tie boxes and paper.

CLEANUP DAYS

Each household may discard 2 bulk items (furniture, appliances, etc.) and 8 bags of non-food items (sheets, towels, clothes, etc).

BULK PICKUP

Schedule your bulk pickup with Brownie Carting.

Bulk means a single item larger than 2'x 2'x 4' or heavier than 50 lbs.

Put bulk items outside for pick-up only on the day scheduled. Each house is allowed one item per week.

CONSTRUCTION/YARD DEBRIS

Special arrangements must be made with an area hauler—at an extra cost—for the pickup of old paint cans, insecticides, batteries, construction debris, and yard waste.

GARBAGE CANS

Store all trash in cans that are:
